



## Juniper shows Early Promise in Season Opener of Carrera Cup

Shaun Juniper (Juniper Racing) commenced his first full season of Carrera Cup with a terrific drive in Race Two, which saw him finish in position 14, after passing some of the more experienced drivers that he chased in the last few rounds of season '06.



Juniper started Race One from grid position 21 but improved race by race to finish on position 14 for the start of Race Three.

Unfortunately Juniper's Round ended on lap one of Race Three when he got tangled in a three car incident that required him retire his Porsche GT3 to the pits, and watch the remainder of the race from Pit lane.

According to CEO of Sherrin MotorSport Alistair Bye, "It was disappointing to see Shaun's weekend come to a halt in Race Three, because he was having an exceptional weekend.

Race Two was a particularly great drive by Shaun, which got him to position 14 for the start of Race Three."

Commenting on his performance in Round One Juniper said, "It was disappointing to sit out Race Three, especially after posting a good result in the previous race. My focus now, is to get the car set-up for the Melbourne Grand Prix."

The Juniper Racing team next returns to the circuit for a non Championship round of Carrera Cup at the F1 ING Grand Prix in Melbourne between 15 – 18 March. This round will be broadcast live on Network Ten.
