



Juniper moves up the grid at the F1 ING Grand Prix

Shaun Juniper (Juniper Racing) continued to impress and improve his performance during the non-Championship round of Carrera Cup at the ING Australian Formula One Grand Prix.

Once again Juniper was the only driver to have never driven the track before but was quickly on the pace with his usual rivals. In Race One Juniper raced well making up four positions on the grid, finishing 17th.

Despite being taken out by another car in the last race Juniper drove well in Race Three and made up another four positions from Race Two, finishing in 16th place.



“The Formula One track was fantastic and a great event. Once I learned the track I really enjoyed the racing at Albert Park with its fast flowing corners and good passing opportunities. It was a little bit disappointing to be hit from behind in the last race but I’ve made a few mistakes myself lately so I understand that these things happen.”

“I’m really looking forward to Winton to put my track learning skills to the test once again. Being a permanent circuit I am hoping I will get the pace a little quicker as the corners won’t be blind or as unforgiving as the street circuits.”

CEO of Sherrin MotorSport, Alistair Bye, said, “It was perfect for the teams to have a non-Championship round early in the season. Shaun is still new at every track at the moment but is adapting very well.

“I’m sure he is looking forward to 2008 already now that he has the valuable street circuit experience of Adelaide and the GP. We have really just used the GP to refine various elements, and Shaun has certainly proved he has got the race craft and speed to challenge for the Tag Heuer Challenge.”

The three Sherrin MotorSport teams will return to the circuit for Round Two of Carrera Cup at Winton Raceway from 18-20 May. The Winton round will be broadcast live on Channel Seven.
