## WEEKEND OF FIRSTS FOR JUNIPER RACING

Shaun Juniper (Juniper Racing) made his first appearance at Winton and in wet conditions for Round Two of the Porsche Carrera Cup on the weekend.

"I haven't raced at Winton before, but I look forward to any new track. It's all part of the excitement of motor racing," said Juniper.

"The wet didn't bother me, in fact I felt good out there and enjoyed all my drives. I just need to focus on gaining a bit more speed."

Both practice sessions saw Juniper drive well and get a feel for the varying conditions, before he settled into a good rhythm in Race One.



Sherrin MotorSport CEO Alistair Bye said, "Shaun had a good start in Race One and held his position. He was side-by-side with Rodney Forbes on a number of corners, but cleverly avoided trouble when Forbes put the pressure on."

Juniper moved up five places in Race One to record his highest finish for the weekend, seventeenth.

The final day of racing on Sunday was challenging for Juniper who battled wet conditions in Race Two and then had to adapt to a dry track in the afternoon.

"This weekend has been a learning curve but I had a good weekend because I love racing," said Juniper.

Round Two of the Carrera Cup will be broadcast on Channel 7 on Saturday 2 June at 1.30pm, with Round Three at Hidden Valley in Darwin from on 22 – 24 June 2007.
