

**JUNIPER STAYS LEVEL HEADED AS IT ALL HAPPENS  
AT ORAN PARK**

In what was a spectacular weekend of racing for the fans, the Australian Carrera Cup served up some of the most exciting racing seen for along time. The tricky wet weather conditions caused havoc throughout the field with Championship leader Alex Davison dropping from first to third in the championship after a disastrous run all weekend.

The TAG Heuer Challenge for non-professional drivers was fiercely contested once again by Shaun Juniper. The driver of the Juniper Racing #11 cup car, drove consistently throughout round 5 of the Carrera Cup Championship this weekend. New to racing at the Oran Park track, Juniper was happy with his race times throughout the weekend which placed him in 19th position.

Recording a personal best overall race position of 14th in race one, Juniper drove skilfully and avoided several collisions when three separate incidents occurred directly in front of him. "I saw Samadi and Davison crash right in front so I had to make some very quick decisions. Lucky for me, they were the right ones" said Juniper.

Juniper was thrown another wild card in race three when he had to complete the race with a flat tyre after it was punctured by some crash debris that was on the racing line. Despite this, he crossed the finish line in an admirable 19th position

Juniper showed again that he is developing his skills every race not only to navigating a track which is new to him, but also recording an impressive lap time of just 1:11.0340.

The next race for the Juniper Racing Team will be at Sandown on September 15-16. "Sandown will be great" Juniper said, "it caps my first 12 months in Carrera Cup so I'm looking forward to it". "Finally I'll be back at a track that I've been to before."
