

JUNIPER FORCED OUT IN RACE THREE

#11 Juniper Racing driver Shaun Juniper was forced out of race three at Bathurst after contact with #27 Sherrin Equipment driver Paul Stokell.

The two drivers were in a close battle for position when Stokell made contact with Juniper heading into Griffins Bend.

Although there was little panel damage to Junipers #11 Porsche, the impact was enough to blow the left rear tyre dashing any hopes he had of finishing the final race of the weekend.

"The car has been fantastic all weekend, the whole Juniper Racing team did an amazing job, especially after the accident in Qualifying," said Juniper.

"I am really looking forward to the next round on the Gold Coast, it's a bit of a home race for me, I have a lot of friends and do so much business on the Gold Coast," added Juniper.

Although Junipers weekend ended on a sour note, the Sunshine Coast property developer did enjoy some impressive results in race one and two improving his overall position in the Tag Heuer Challenge.

Sherrin MotorSport team manager, Alistair Bye was impressed with Junipers progress throughout the race weekend even after the DNF in race three.

"It was a real shame Shaun (Juniper) didn't finish the weekend on a positive, but he made some fantastic progress over the weekend." said Alistair Bye.

"His last lap move in race two was particularly pleasing, he showed how much his race craft has improved throughout the season," added Bye.

Shaun Juniper will be in action in his #11 Juniper Racing Porsche when the final round of the 2007 Carrera Cup Series gets underway on October 18 at the annual Gold Coast Lexmark Indy 300 event.
