"It was my first full season of Carrera Cup racing and I am really pleased with the improvements I have made during the year," said Juniper.

Fortunately for Juniper, he will have a slightly shorter wait to get back behind the wheel of race car, his Juniper Racing Porsche 911 GT3 RSR is currently being prepared for the Dubai 24 hour race being run in January 2008.
